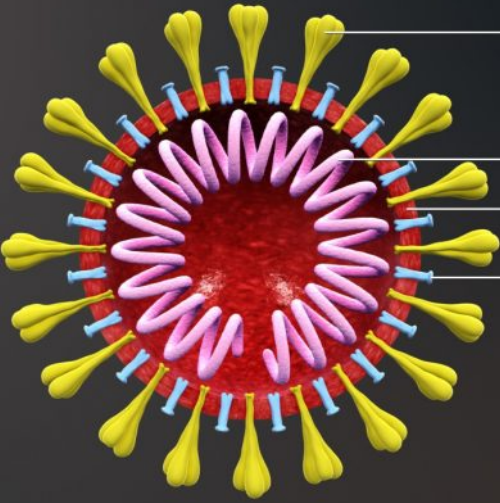
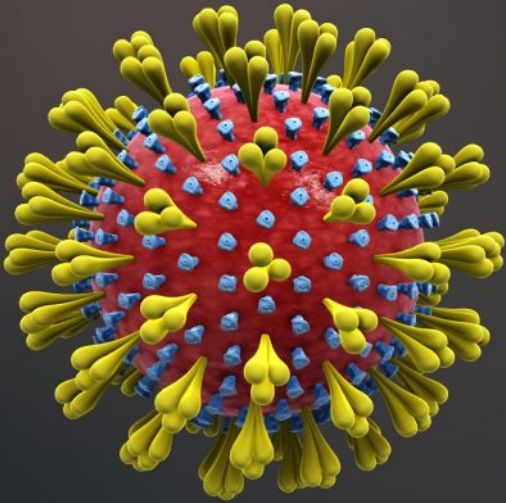


COVID 19 threat: College closed for the month
