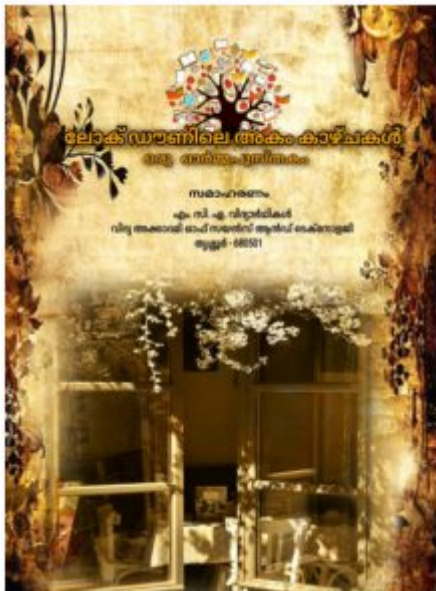


Alamkode Leelakrishnan releases MCA students' Ormapusthakam
