

EEE Dept conducts 10-day training on “Power Quality” a second time



After the successful completion of the first Power Quality Training Program in January 2021, the EEE Dept organized a second edition of the 10-day programme during March 2021. As in the first edition, the training was given by technical experts from JEF Techno Solutions, Bengaluru, Gossen Metrowatt Pvt. Ltd, Germany and Merus Power, Finland.

Inauguration

The formal inauguration of the program was held online on 18 March 2021. The chief guests for the function were two of the resource persons for the training program, Er Michael Schulze, Sales Manager, Gossen Metrowatt, Germany and Er Anil Kumar P, Jef Techno Solutions, Bengaluru. The session was presided over by Dr Saji C B, Principal. The session was inaugurated by Dr Santhosh Prasannan, Chairman, VICT. Dr P Rajan, Director of KSEB (Transmission, Operation and REES Division) delivered the

keynote address. Dr Sudha Balagopalan, Dean Academics, who was the key person in bringing the training into the campus, detailed the contents and structure of the training.
